

It's all ... ABOUT BOATING SAFELY



The United States Coast Guard Auxiliary's Huntington Flotilla will be conducting About Boating Safely (ABS) courses as follows:

- April 14th, 9AM 6PM; Huntington Library, 338 Main Street, Huntington, NY.
- ♣ May 5th, 9AM 6PM; Northport Library,151 Laurel Avenue, Northport, NY
- ♣ June 2nd, 9AM 6PM; Halesite Fire Department, 1 New York Ave., Halesite, NY

These courses meet the boating safely certificate requirements needed for those born after May 1, 1996; and for those on personal watercraft.

Our courses are conducted by U.S. Coast Guard trained and certified instructors, facility owners, coxswains, and crew qualified members of the USCG Auxiliary. In addition to presenting the course curriculum, these individuals will be available to address a wide array of boating questions as they arise.

Introduction to Boating – Maritime Law – Boat Safety Equipment – Safe Boating – Navigation – Boating Problems – Trailering, Storing and Protecting Your Boat – Hunting and Fishing, Water-skiing and River Boating
